These communities often utilize traditional, collective care mechanisms to prevent child labour by emphasizing communal responsibility and kinship networks.

AARAMBH's approach for better family's well beings and Comprehensive Community Care Mechanism on Child Labour and Child Marriage Prevention has proved significant changes in the life of Children, families and the Community in transitioning child protection framework from a purely legal context to one rooted in the community's own customs and social fabric.

AARAMBH under their successful better families well beings and Community Care mechanism has established strong family bonds and community ties by engaging Sarpanchs from 12 Gram Panchayats, District Government, Families through a better dialogue on culturally relevant events and practices, by fostering strong family bonds among children and youths and ties with village community members by utilizing assessment tools that are specific to the needs of tribal families

which can help them in understanding their strengths and resilience in growing their local based livelihoods options. AARAMBH's strategies and resources aim to enhance family engagement and strengthen the overall well-being of tribal families, by ensuring that most needy are now actively involved in their children education and also community caring.
